


















Dashboard 1: Summary

Dashboard Summary – This dashboard provides a holistic view of healthcare performance across GCC countries, tracking hospital revenues, profitability, staffing, and operational efficiency. It enables stakeholders to assess financial outcomes and resource utilization by city and hospital.

Key Metrics Displayed:

Total Revenue: \$92.5K – Strong revenue generation across hospitals in the GCC.

Total Profit: \$45.7K – Almost half of revenue is retained as profit.

Net Profit Margin: 49.4% – High efficiency in cost control and profitability.

Total Staff: 1.0M – A large and distributed workforce across hospitals.

Average Wait Time: 15 minutes - Patient flow is well managed with minimal delays.

Filters Available:

- Interactive slicers for Hospital Name, Country and City to allow tailored analysis.

Dashboard 1: Core Visual Insights

Revenue & Profit Insights (by City):

- Top Revenue City: Kuwait City \$19.0K revenue, \$9.0K profit
- Other High Performers: Muscat \$14.8K revenue, \$7.1K profit, Doha \$14.7K revenue, \$7.2K profit, Manama \$14.5K revenue, \$7.1K profit
- Lower Revenue Cities: Sharjah, Jeddah, Abu Dhabi, Dubai, Riyadh (-\$4–6K revenue, \$2–3K profit each)

Hospital Performance:

- Revenue per Bed (Top Hospital): Med Life Hospital \$0.20 per bed
- Other strong performers: Care Life, Care Plus, AI Plus, Med Noor Hospitals (-\$0.19 each)
- Lowest Performer: Al Life Hospital \$0.16 per bed
